<p>Formulated based on the Guide to Pre-primary Curriculum issued by the Curriculum Development Council of Education Bureau and according to the needs and development of children of different ages. With balanced arrangement of passive and active activities in the daily schedule, children have sufficient time for learning theme-based contents, music, physical fitness and optional activities. Religious teaching and moral education are also integrated to foster morality of children.</p> <p>We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>	
Learning / Teaching approach & activities	
<p>'Theme-based approach' is the core of our curriculum supported with 'topic studies' and high scope elements. The optional group activity teaching mode is adopted, English Phonics is taught by native-speaking specialists and Putonghua teachers are employed. Outdoor visits by themes and for life experience purpose are arranged for students of all grades. Through various learning experiences, development in all aspects is promoted and good learning attitude is fostered.</p>
